



Sparkles and Snowflakes Shawl

Yarn:

Katia Gatsby from Favoritgarner

5 balls in one colour, 1 ball in another colour (the one in the photo is made in colours 21 and 88500).

Alternative yarn:

Katia Brisa

4 - 5 balls in one colour, 1 ball in another colour

Katia Cotton Alpacka

4 balls in one colour, 1 ball in another colour

Katia Cotton Stretch

4 balls in one colour, 1 ball in another colour

Hook: 3,5

Size: In Katia Gatsby, a shawl is approx: 73 cm from the neck and down and 153 cm wide.

UK terms:

Cl - colour

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Ch - chain

St - stitch

Dc -double crochet

tr – treble crochet

Htr – half treble crochet

Dtr – double treble crochet

Chsp – chain space

Ss - slip stitch

Bptr –back post treble crochet

Tr2tog - 2 treble crochet together. Make a tr but only pull the yarn through 2 loops, make another tr, pull the yarn through 2 loops, yarn over and pull the yarn through all loops on hook.

Tips:

- *It is made from the bottom and up.*
- It is worked in rows back and forth.
- *Odd rows are the right side, even rows are the wrong side.*
- Every row, accept for the last two rows on the sides, starts with ch 4, which acts as dtr.
- The shawl is supposed to be a bit airy and light. If it is not, try a bigger hook size.
- The initial ch 4 on each row acts as dtr.

Ch 8, ss in first ch.

Row 1

In ch-ring, ch 4, dtr, ch 5, tr2tog, ch 5, 2 dtr. Turn.

Row 2

Ch 4, dtr in next dtr, ch 5, dc in chsp, ch 5, dc in next chsp, ch 5, 1 dtr in each of the two dtr. Turn.

Row 3

Ch 4, dtr in next dtr, ch 5, tr2tog in chsp, ch 5, dc in next chsp, ch 5, tr2tog in next chsp, ch 5, 1 dtr in each of the two dtr. Turn.

Row 4

Ch 4, dtr in next dtr, ch 5, dc in chsp, ch 5, *dc in next chsp, ch 5, repeat * to the end of the row, 1 dtr in each of the two var dtr. Turn.






Row 5Ch 4, dtr in next dtr, ch 5, tr2tog in chsp, ch 5, * dc in next chsp, ch 5, tr2tog in next chsp , ch 5, repeat * to the end of the row, 1 dtr in each of the two dtr. Turn.

Repeat rows 4 and 5 until you reach the length you want. I have repeated rows 4 - 5 totally 35 times. Finish by making row 4. Turn. Fasten off.

Edging 1 (This row is made on only two sides, photo 13) In the same colour as before. This row is made from the right side.

Dc in the last dtr in the top left corner of the shawl, photo 5, * ch 2, **tr** photo $3 + \mathbf{ch} 2 + \mathbf{tr}$ in next dtr on the side photo 7, ch 2, dc in next dtr photo 8 - 9, repeat * to the end of the side, dc in ch8sp, **ch** $2 + \mathbf{tr} + \mathbf{ch} 2 + \mathbf{tr} + \mathbf{ch} 2 + \mathbf{dc}$ in ch8sp, ****ch** 2, **tr** + **ch** 2 + **tr** in next dtr on the side, repeat ** to the end of the side, ch 2 and finish this row with a ss in the first dtr på on the top side. Fasten off.

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


Edging 2 in another colour, start on the neck side photo 13. This row is also made frpm the right side. Do in the second dtr on the neck side, *ch 4, dc + ch 3 + dc (picot) in next dc, photo 10, repeat* to the end of this side, ch 4, dc in dtr, dc in next dtr.

Along next side, ch 3, *dc in tr, htr in ch2sp, ch 6, ss in 5th ch from hook, ch 5, ss in the same st as previous ss, ch 5, ss in the same st as previous, (snowflake), ch 1, htr in the same ch2sp, dc in next tr, ch 1, bptr in next dc, ch 1, repeat* to the middle of the shawl (the bottom), bptr in tr, ch 1, dtr in ch2sp, ch 6, ss in fifth ch from hook, ch 5, ss in the same st as previous ss, ch 5, ss in the same st as previous ss, ch 1, dtr in the same ch2sp *photo 12*, ch 1, bptr in tr, ch 1, bptr in dc, ch 1 ** dc in tr, htr in ch2sp, ch 6, ss in fifth ch from hook, ch 5, ss in the same st as previous ss, ch 5, ss in the same st as previous ss, ch 1, htr in the same ch2sp, dc in next tr, ch 1, bptr in next dc, ch 1, repeat**to the end of this side, but after your last dc in tr, ch 3, dc in the first dtr on the neck side, ss in initial dc. Fasten off.







Tie your ends with double knots on the backside before you weave them in. If you have made your shawl in Katia Gatsby, it does not need to be blocked.

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
