



Mochila Rhapsody

Yarn from www.favoritgarner.se

The black bag is made in Svarta Fårets Tilda (50 g). The white one is made in Katia Capri. You will need more yarn in colour A and F than in colours B-E. One ball of yarn in colour F might be enough, but some of the pattern testers needed 2 balls.

| Colour E x 1 | pink/purple 543 | cerise 82138 |
| Colour F x 2 | green 538 | green 82149 |

Alternative yarn (see photos in the end of this pattern)

Scheepjes Catona A + F x 2 balls, B-E x 1 ball
 Katia Tencel Cotton A + F x 2 balls, B-E x 1 ball
 Scheepjes Cahlista A x 3 balls, B-F x 2 balls

Size: Approximately height 27 cm, bag bottom 16 cm across, depending on your crochet gauge.

Hook: 2,0 – 2,5 mm depending on your crochet gauge, 1,5 for the chain stitch when you make the bag strap.

US terms used:

St - stitch
sc – single crochet
Ch – chain
Sl st – slip stitch
Inc - increase

Useful tips before you start:

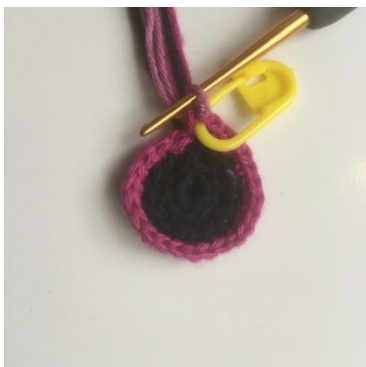
- The bag is made of sc in the back loop only.
- The bag bottom is worked in the round, increasing until you have made 19 rounds. You can use a stitch marker and put it in the first st of each round so you know when you start a new round.
- When you change colour, leave the last sc before the colour change unfinished, and close the st with the new colour.
- You do not fasten off when you are making a mochila, not until it is finished. You carry the unused strands under the working stitches. Try to keep your yarn balls in a way to prevent tangling. Remember to check the inside of the bag now and then so you do not leave any strands behind, or if you need to stretch the yarn gently.
- The project needs to feel stiff when you are crocheting a mochila. You crochet tight.
- Count the stitches now and then, frogging is difficult when you are making a mochila and very time consuming.
- If the bag bottom is not as flat as you want it, block it before you start with the diagram.

Make a magic circle using colour A. (Or make a chain ring, ch 4, sl st in initial ch st, ch 1)

Round 1: 8 sc in the ring. **8 sc**

Round 2: 2 sc in each st. **16 sc**

Varv 3: Using B, (sc, 2 sc in the same st) x 8. **24 sc**



Round 4: Inc in every third st.

(using E 2 sc, using D 2 sc in the same st, using F 2 sc, using D 2 sc in the same st, using C 2 sc, using D 2 sc in the same st, using F 2 sc, using D 2 sc in the same st) x 2. **32 sc**



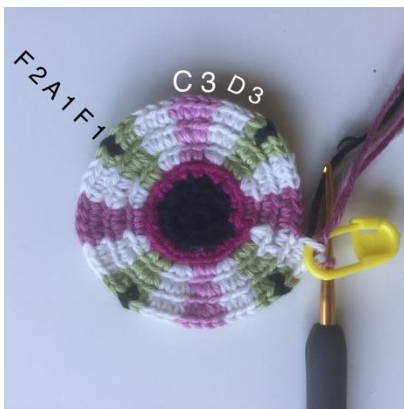
Round 5: Inc in every second st.

(using E 1 sc, 2 sc in the same st, using D 1 sc, 2 sc in the same st, using F 1 sc, 2 sc in the same st, using D 1 sc, 2 sc in the same st, using C 1 sc, 2 sc in the same st, using D 1 sc, 2 sc in the same st, using F 1 sc, 2 sc in the same st, using D 1 sc, 2 sc in the same st) x 2. **48 sc**



Round 6: Inc in every 6th st.

(Using E 1 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 1 sc, using D 3 sc, using F 1 sc, 1 sc using F + 1 sc using A in the same st, using F 1 sc, using D 3 sc, using C 1 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 1 sc, using D 3 sc, using F 1 sc, 1 sc using F + 1 sc using A in the same st, using F 1 sc, using D 3 sc) x 2. **56 sc**



Round 7: Inc in every 7th st.

(using E 3 sc, 2 sc in the same st, using D 3 sc, using F 2 sc, using A 1 sc, using F 2 sc in the same st, using D 3 sc, using C 3 sc, 2 sc in the same st, using D 3 sc, using F 2 sc, using A 1 sc, using F 2 sc in the same st, using D 3 sc) x 2. **64 sc**



Round 8: Inc in every 8th stitch.

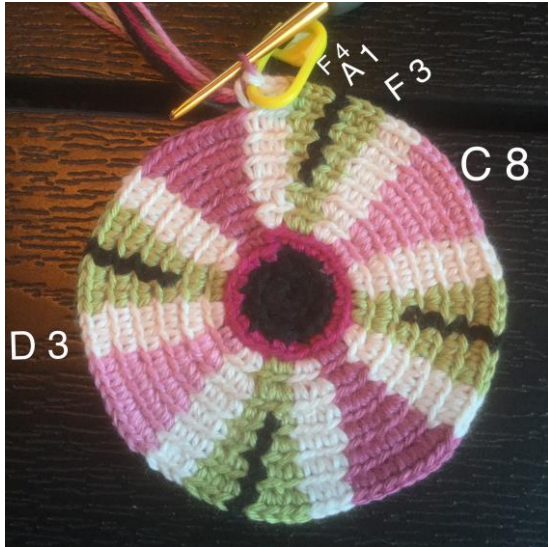
(Using E 2 sc in the same st, 4 sc, using D 3 sc, using F 2 sc in the same st, 1 sc, using A 1 sc, using F 2 sc, using D 3 sc, using C 2 sc in the same st, 4 sc, using D 3 sc, using F 2 sc in the same st, 1 sc, using A 1 sc, using F 2 sc, using D 3 sc) x 2. **72 sc**



Round 9: 16 inc

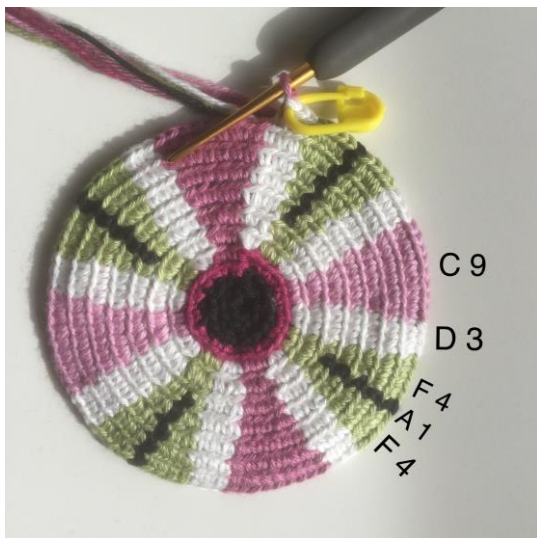
(Using E 4 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 2 sc in the same st, using D 3 sc, using F 3 sc, using A 1 sc, using F 2 sc in the same st, 2 sc in the same st, using D 3 sc, using C 4 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 2 sc in the same st, using D 3 sc, using F 3 sc, using A 1 sc, using F 2 sc in the same st, 2 sc in the same st, using D 3 sc) x 2.

88 sc



Round 10: Inc in every 11th st.

(Using E 1 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 6 sc, using D 3 sc, using F 1 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 1 sc, using A 1 sc, using F 4 sc, using D 3 sc, using C 1 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 6 sc, using D 3 sc, using F 1 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 1 sc, using A 1 sc, using F 4 sc, using D 3 sc) x 2. **96 sc**



Round 11: Inc in every 12th st.

(Using E 4 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 4 sc, using D 3 sc, using F 4 sc, using A 1 sc + using F 1 sc in the same st, using F 4 sc, using D 3 sc, using C 4 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 4 sc, using D 3 sc, using F 4 sc, using A 1 sc + using F 1 sc in the same st, using F 4 sc, using D 3 sc) x 2. **104 sc**



Round 12: 8 inc.

(Using E 1 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 8 sc, using D 3 sc, using F 1 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 2 sc, using A 1 sc, using F 5 sc, using D 3 sc, using C 1 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 8 sc, using D 3 sc, using F 1 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 2 sc, using A 1 sc, using F 5 sc, using D 3 sc) x 2. **112 sc**



Round 13: 16 inc.

(Using D 2 sc in the same st, using E 9 sc, using D 2 sc in the same st, 3 sc, 2 sc in the same st, using F 4 sc, using A 1 sc, using F 4 sc, using D 2 sc in the same st, 3 sc, 2 sc in the same st, using C 9 sc, using D 2 sc in the same st, 3 sc, 2 sc in the same st, using F 4 sc, using A 1 sc, using F 4 sc, using D 2 sc in the same st, 3 sc) x 2. **128 sc**



Round 14: 8 inc.

(Using D 3 sc, using E 7 sc, using D 3 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 5 sc, using F 3 sc, using A 1 sc, using F 3 sc, using D 3 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 5 sc, using C 7 sc, using D 3 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 5 sc, using F 3 sc, using A 1 sc, using F 3 sc, using D 3 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 2 sc) x 2. **136 sc**



Round 15: 8 inc

(Using D 1 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 2 sc, using E 5 sc, using D 9 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 2 sc, using F 2 sc, using A 1 sc, using F 2 sc, using D 9 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 2 sc, using C 5 sc, using D 9 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 2 sc, using F 2 sc, using A 1 sc, using F 2 sc, using D 8 sc) x 2. **144 sc**



Round 16: 16 inc.

(Using D 4 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 1 sc, using E 3 sc, using D 1 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 11 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 1 sc, using F 1 sc, using A 1 sc, using F 1 sc, using D 1 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 11 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 1 sc, using C 3 sc, using D 1 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 11 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 1 sc, using F 1 sc, using A 1 sc, using F 1 sc, using D 1 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 7 sc) x 2. **160 sc**



Round 17: 8 inc.

(Using D 8 sc, using E 1 sc, using D 7 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 11 sc, using F 1 sc, using D 7 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 11 sc, using C 1 sc, using D 7 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 11 sc, using F 1 sc, using D 7 sc, 2 sc in the same st, 3 sc) x 2. **168 sc**



Round 18: 8 inc.

Using only colour D. Inc are made in the top of each petal. **176 sc**

Round 19: 4 inc.

Using only colour A, make 4 inc on this round. **180 sc**



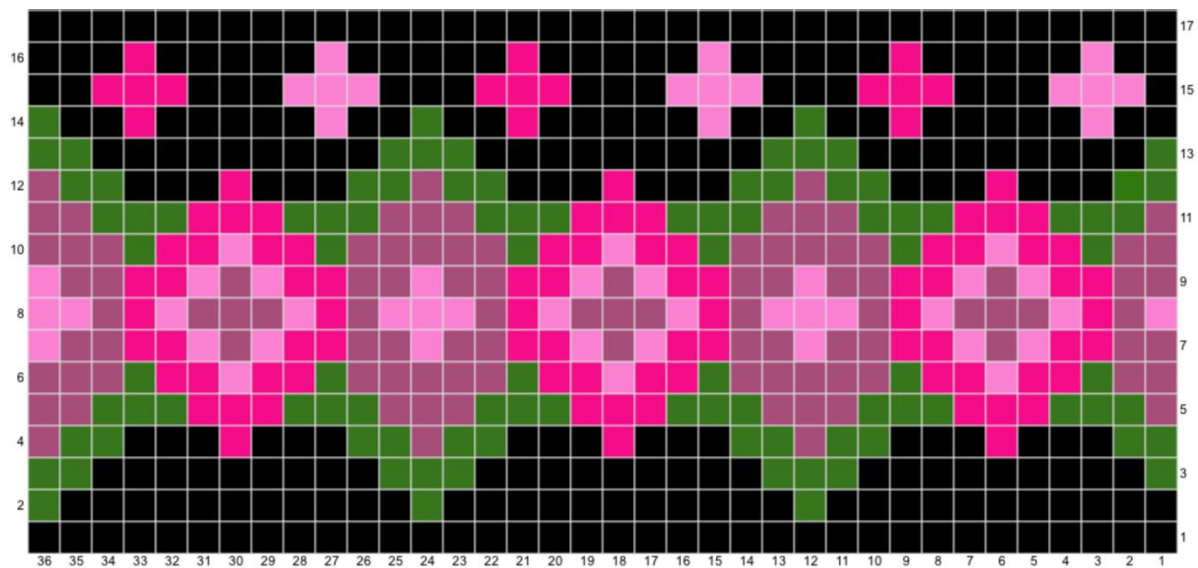
Block your circle if needed to make it totally flat. **Remember, do not fasten off!**

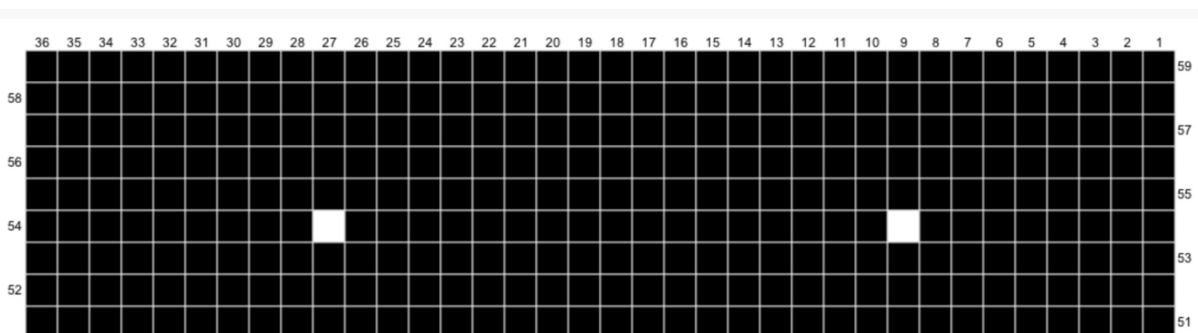
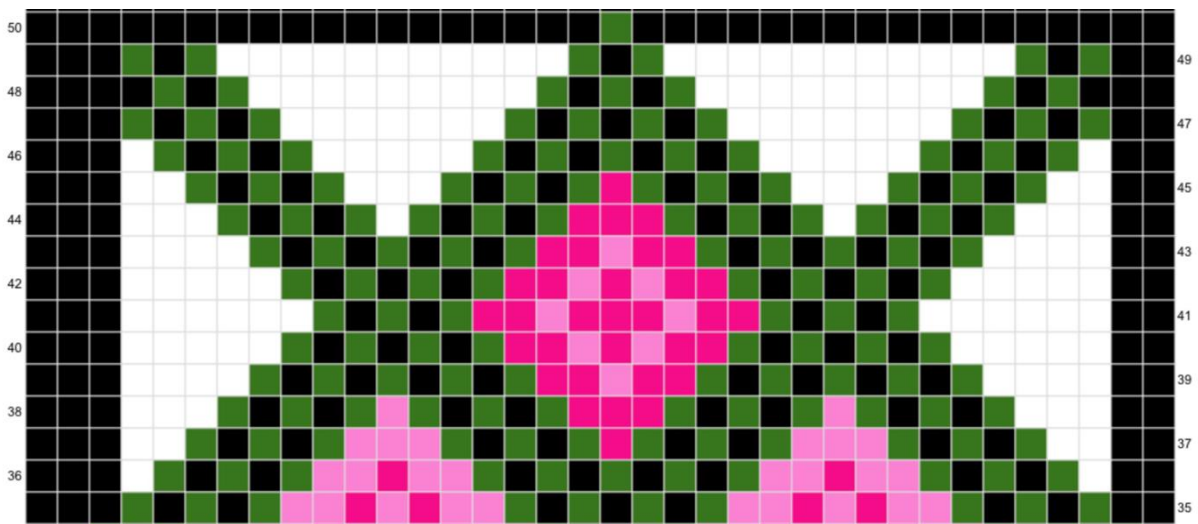
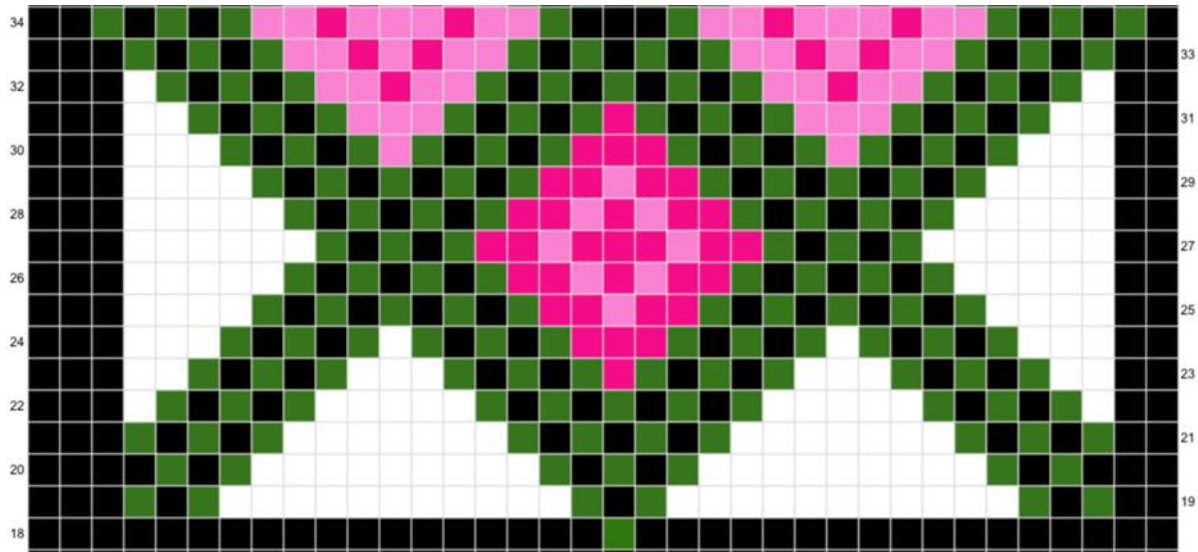
Diagram

From now on you make no more increases. Repeat every row, square 1 – 36, 5 times on each round. Every round starts in square 1.

The colours of the squares in the diagram represents the following colours:

When you have finished **round 54**, put 10 stitch markers around, 18 st between each stitch marker (the white squares are where you put your stitch markers).

Round 55 – Make string holes

Follow the diagram, but stop 2 st before every marker, ch 4, skip 5 st including the one with the marker, follow the diagram.

Round 56 Follow the diagram, but when you come to the string holes, 5 sc around chain space + all threads, NOTICE crochet tight around the threads so they are hidden under your sc.

Make round 57 – 59. Finish the last round with a sl st. Fasten off and weave in the ends on the inside of the bag,

String

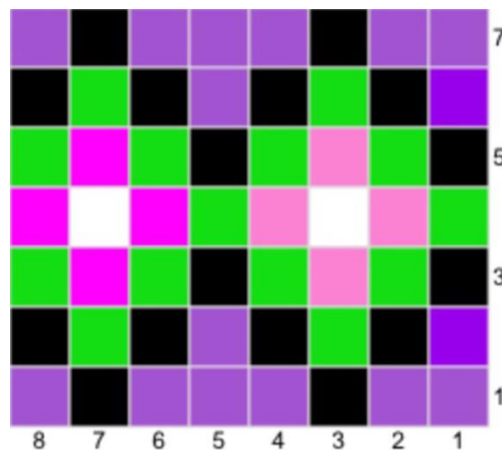
Make a string out of 9 threads in desired length. Pull the string through the holes. If you like tassels, make two and put on each end of the string.

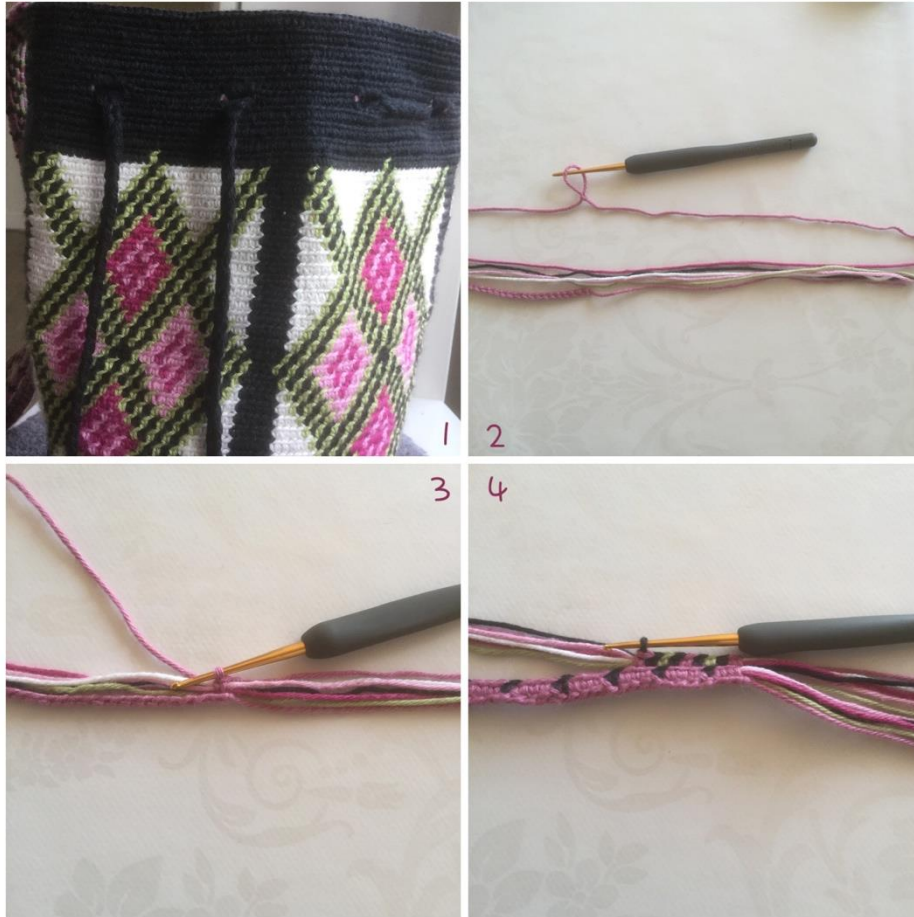
Bag strap

With hook 1, 5 mm, ch 297 using colour E. It is important to chain tight. Fasten off and leave a 5 cm long end. Add the other 5 colours and be sure to have 5 cm ends. Use your 2,0 mm hook again for the rest of the bag strap. Make a loop using E and continue to crochet the same way as previously, but using the bag strap diagram below.

NOTICE: Fasten off after each row. All rows are worked from the right side only, from right to left.

If needed, block your strap. Attach the strap to the bag on the inside.

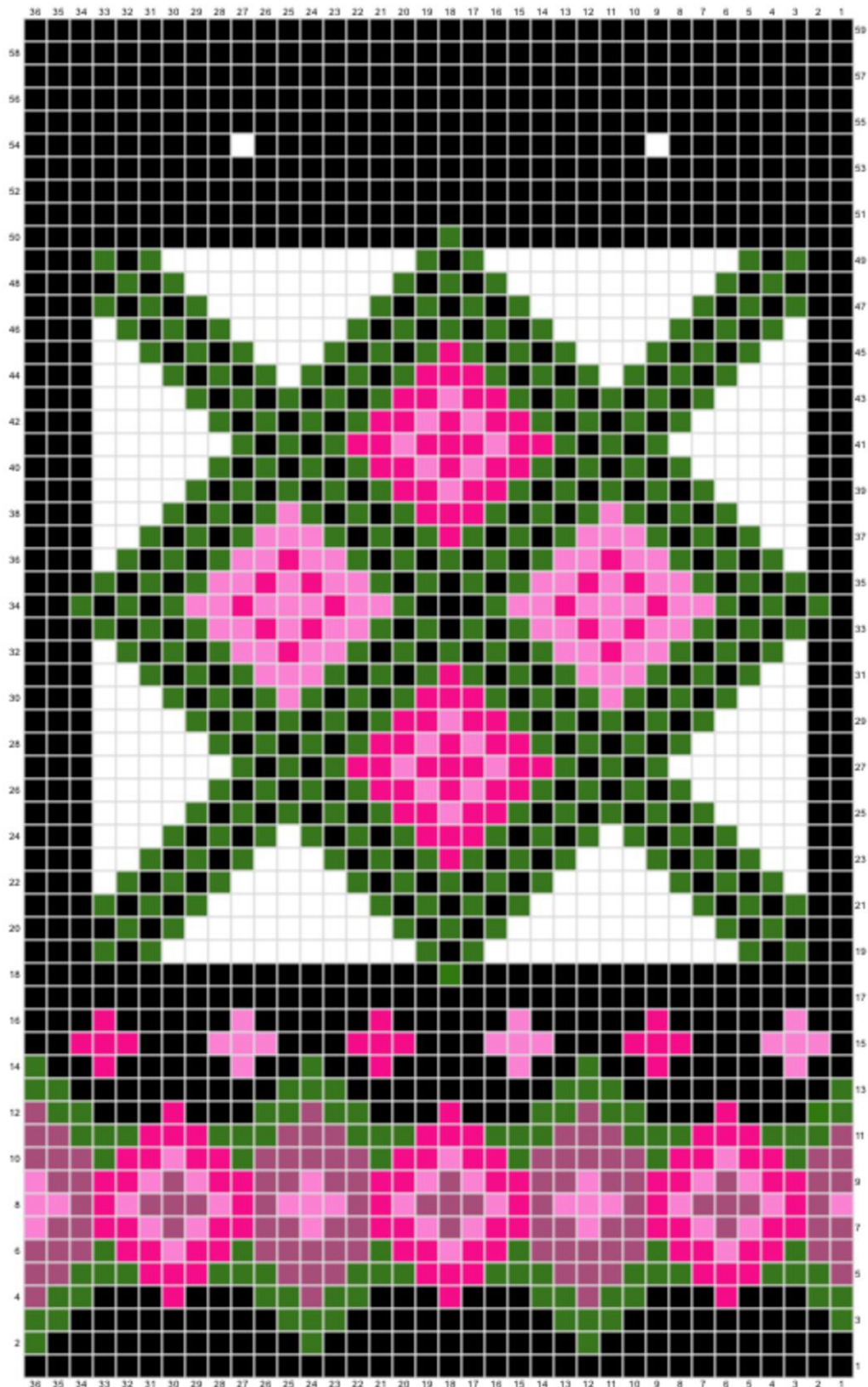
