







Hat Antumn Breeze - Design Ellinor Widéen Frostvirka

Yarn: Viking Björk ("old" Björk 90 % cotton and 10% merino wool, "new" 50 % cotton and 50 % bamboo) 1 ball x 3 colours. Depending on your crochet gauge, you might need an extra ball of colour A (the rib). The colour numbers in the photo are: 503, 520, and 523.

Alternative yarn: Arwetta Classic Filocana (80 % merino wool, 20 % nylon) 1 ball x 3 colours. You can find a hat made in this yarn on the blog. I have used colours 955, 956, 957 and three stripes in 807.

Hook: 3,0 mm for the first part (rounds 1 - 8), 2,5 mm for the following rounds (9 - 52)

Size: Adult. In Arwetta Classic your hat will be smaller than in Viking Björk, so it is important to try the hat after the first round so it fits.

If you want a bigger size, add ch 4 from the start. If you want a smaller, decrease ch 4. If you want a bigger or smaller hat than that, increase or decrease 8, 12, 16 etcetera. NOTICE that the stitch count on the rounds will differ if you make it bigger or smaller.

US terms used:

St - stitch

Sc – single crochet

Ch – chain

Sl st – slip stitch

Ldc – long double crochet made in round below.

Chsp – chain space

Dc - Double crochet

Hdc – half double crochet

frpdc – front post double crochet

Hook 3,0, ch 124 using colour A, sl st in initial ch 1.






Round 1: Ch 3 (acts as dc). 1 dc in each st around, sl st in initial ch 3. 124 dc

NOTICE: Try it on to see that it fits before you continue.

Round 2: Ch 3 (acts as dc), dc, 1 frpdc in each of the following 2 dc, (1 dc in each of the following 2 dc, 1 frpdc in each of the following 2 dc) repeat around, sl st in initial ch 3.





Rounds 3 - 8: Ch 3 (acts as dc), dc, 1 frpdc in each of the following 2 frpdc, (1 dc in each of the following 2 dc, 1 frpdc in each of the following 2 frpdc) repeat around, sl st in initial ch 3.

If the rib starts to look curly, it will become flat again if you block it when the hat is finished.

Two different ways to make the seond part of the hat:

- 1. It is worked in the round without a sI st when the round is finished. It can be helpful to use a st marker so you know when a new round starts. When you change colour, leave the last sc before the colour change unfinished, and close the st with the new colour.
- 2. Each round ends with a sl st. If the next round starts wit a sc, ch 1. If it starts with a hdc, ch 2.

Hook 2,5.

Round 9: Using colour B, 1 sc in the back loop of each st around.



Round 10: 1 sc in each st around, but decrease 8 st evenly by sc 2 together. 116 sc.

Round 11: 1 sc in each st around.







Round 12: Using colour C, 1 hdc in the back loop of each of the following 2 sc, ch 3, skip 2 sc, (1 hdc in the back loop of each of the following 2 sc, ch 3, skip 2 sc) repeat around. 58 hdc.



Round 13: Using colour B (1 sc in the back loop of each of the 2 hdc, 1 ldc in each of the 2 skipped st on round 12, you make them around chsp) repeat around. 58 hdc and 58 sc.



Round 14: 1 sc in each st around.

Round 15: 1 hdc in the back loop of each of the following 2 sc, ch 3, skip 2 sc, (1 hdc in the back loop of each of the following 2 sc, ch 3, skip 2 sc) repeat around. 58 hdc.

Round 16: Using colour C (1 sc in the back loop of each of the 2 hdc, 1 ldc in each of the 2 skipped st on round 14, you make them around chsp) repeat around.

Round 17: 1 sc in each st around.

Round 18: 1 hdc in the back loop of each of the following 2 sc, ch 3, skip 2 sc, (1 hdc in the back loop of each of the following 2 sc, ch 3, skip 2 sc) repeat around.

Round 19: Using colour B (1 sc in the back loop of each of the 2 hdc, 1 ldc in each of the 2 skipped st on round 17, you make them around chsp) repeat around.

Round 20: 1 sc in each st around, but decrease 8 st evenly by sc 2 together. 108 sc.

Round 21: 1 sc in each st around.

Round 22: Using colour A, 1 hdc in the back loop of each of the following 2 sc, ch 3, skip 2 sc, (1 hdc in the back loop of each of the following 2 sc, ch 3, skip 2 sc) repeat around. 54 hdc.

Round 23: Using colour B (1 sc in the back loop of each of the 2 hdc, 1 ldc in each of the 2 skipped st on round 21, you make them around chsp) repeat around.

Round 24: 1 sc in each st around.

Round 25: 1 hdc in the back loop of each of the following 2 sc, ch 3, skip 2 sc, (1 hdc in the back loop of each of the following 2 sc, ch 3, skip 2 sc) repeat around.







Round 26: Using colour A (1 sc in the back loop of each of the 2 hdc, 1 ldc in each of the 2 skipped st on round 24, you make them around chsp) repeat around.

Round 27: 1 sc in each st around.

Round 28: 1 hdc in the back loop of each of the following 2 sc, ch 3, skip 2 sc, (1 hdc in the back loop of each of the following 2 sc, ch 3, skip 2 sc) repeat around.

Round 29: Using colour B (1 sc in the back loop of each of the 2 hdc, 1 ldc in each of the 2 skipped st on round 27, you make them around chsp) repeat around.

Round 30: 1 sc in each st around, but decrease 12 st evenly by sc 2 together. 96 sc.

Round 31: 1 sc in each st around.

Round 32: Using colour C, 1 hdc in the back loop of each of the following 2 sc, ch 3, skip 2 sc, (1 hdc in the back loop of each of the following 2 sc, ch 3, skip 2 sc) repeat around. **48 hdc**.

Round 33: Using colour B (1 sc in the back loop of each of the 2 hdc, 1 ldc in each of the 2 skipped st on round 31, you make them around chsp) repeat around.

Round 34: 1 sc in each st around.

Round 35: 1 hdc in the back loop of each of the following 2 sc, ch 3, skip 2 sc, (1 hdc in the back loop of each of the following 2 sc, ch 3, skip 2 sc) repeat around.

Round 36: Using colour C (1 sc in the back loop of each of the 2 hdc, 1 ldc in each of the 2 skipped st on round 31, you make them around chsp) repeat around.

Round 37: 1 sc in each st around.

Round 38: 1 hdc in the back loop of each of the following 2 sc, ch 3, skip 2 sc, (1 hdc in the back loop of each of the following 2 sc, ch 3, skip 2 sc) repeat around.

Round 39: Using colour B (1 sc in the back loop of each of the 2 hdc, 1 ldc in each of the 2 skipped st on round 31, you make them around chsp) repeat around.

On the following rounds, you can try your hat on every second round. If you want a more beanie hat you can add more rounds witch one sc in each st, between the decreasing rows. My hat in Arwetta yarn has an extra sc round between every decreasing round.

Round 40: 1 sc in each st around, but decrease 16 st evenly by sc 2 together. 80 sc.

Round 41: 1 sc in each st around.

Round 42: 1 sc in each st around, but decrease 20 st evenly by sc 2 together. 60 sc.

Rounds 43 - 44: 1 sc in each st around.

Round 45: 1 sc in each st around, but decrease 10 st evenly by sc 2 together. 50 sc.

Rounds 46 - 48: 1 sc in each st around.

Round 49: 1 sc in each st around, but decrease 10 st evenly by sc 2 together. 40 sc.

Rounds 50 - 52: 1 sc in each st around.

Fasten off, but keep a long end to sew your hat together with at the top. Sew through every second st and pull. Sew in all the ends on the inside.
