







Hotpad – Dinner for two – design by Ellinor Widéen Frostvirka

Yarn: 3 balls of Katia Capri from favoritgarner.se is what you need to cover 2 cork hotpads in size 22 cm across.

Hook: 3,0

Tips:

- Notice that your hotpad cover need to be tight. That is why your crochet cover will not lie flat when you crochet the last rows.
- If you start your next round with the same color as the previous one, your first dc is made by ch 3.

US terms used:

CI - color

St - stitch

Sc – single crochet

Ch - chain

SI st - slip stitch

Chsp – chain space

Dc – double crochet

Tr - treble crochet

Pop – popcorn, 4 dc into same st, remove hook from loop, put the hook into initial dc, pick up your dropped loop again and pull through loops on your hook, like a sl st.

Trpop – treble crochet popcorn, 4 tr into same st, remove hook from loop, put the hook into initial tr, pick up your dropped loop again and pull through loops on your hook, like a sl st.







Round 1: In cl A, make a magic ring, 6 pop with ch 3 between pops, sl st in initial pop. Initial pop is made by ch 3. 6 pop, 6 chsp

Round 2: CL A (pop in pop, ch 1, pop in chsp, ch 1) repeat around, sl st in pop. 12 pop, 12 chsp

Round 3: Cl A (pop in pop, ch 1, skip chsp, pop in pop, ch 1, pop in chsp, ch 1) repeat around, sl st in pop. 18 pop, 18 chsp

Round 4: Cl A (pop in pop, ch 1, skip chsp, pop in pop, ch 1, skip chsp, pop in pop, ch 1, pop in chsp, ch 1) repeat around, sl st in pop. 24 pop, 24 chsp

Round 5: Cl A *(pop in pop, ch 1, skip chsp) x 3, pop in pop, ch 1, pop in chsp, ch 1, repeat from*around, sl st in pop. 30 pop, 30 chsp

Round 6: Cl B *(trpop in pop, ch 1, skip chsp) x 4, trpop in pop, ch 1, trpop in chsp, ch 1, repeat from*around, sl st in trpop. 36 trpop, 36 chsp

Round 7: Cl C, as round 6, but repeat the parentheses 5 times and troop is made in troop instead of in pop. 42 trpop, 42 chsp

Round 8: CI C, as round 7, but repeat the parentheses 6 times. 48 trpop, 48 chsp

Round 9: Cl A, (5 dc in chsp, skip trpop, sc in chsp, skip trpop) repeat around, sl st in dc. 24 groups of 5 dc, 24 sc

Round 10: Cl B, (4 dc in the back loop of sc, skip 2 dc, sc in the back loop of dc, skip 2 dc) repeat around, sl st in dc. 24 groups of 4 dc, 24 sc

Round 11: Cl A (1 dc in each of 4 dc, skip sc) repeat around, sl st in dc. 96 dc

Round 12: Cl A, 1 dc in each st around, sl st in dc. 96 dc

Round 13 - 14: Cl A, 1 sc in each st around. Save a long end after your last round. 96 sc

NOTICE, if you crochet very tight and feel that your crochet cover is too small for your cork hotpad, just add a few more rounds with sc in each st until it fits.

Weave in the ends, except the one on your last round. Cover your cork hotpad with your crochet cover and use the long end to make it fit as tight as you want it to (you might want to take it off now and then to wash it, so do not fasten it too tight)

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I have also made a smaller cover for a cork hotpad in the size **18** cm across. But, for this one I used 4 colors of leftover yarn so the colors A-C are not the same as in the photo.

Round 1: Cl A Make a magic ring, 6 pop with ch 3 between pops, sl st in initial pop. Initial pop is made by ch 3. 6 pop, 6 chsp

Round 2: CL A (pop in pop, ch 1, pop in chsp, ch 1) repeat around, sl st in pop. 12 pop, 12 chsp

Round 3: Cl A (pop in pop, ch 1, skip chsp, pop in pop, ch 1, pop in chsp, ch 1) repeat around, sl st in pop. 18 pop, 18 chsp

Round 4: Cl B *(trpop in pop, ch 1, skip chsp, trpop in pop, ch 1, skip chsp, trpop in pop, ch 1, trpop in chsp, ch 1) repeat around, sl st in trpop. 24 trpop, 24 chsp

Round 5: Cl C *(trpop in trpop, ch 1, skip chsp) x 3, trpop in trpop, ch 1, trpop in chsp, ch 1, repeat from*around, sl st in trpop. 30 trpop, 30 chsp

Round 6: CI C, as round 5 but repeat the parentheses 4 times, sl st in troop. 36 troop, 36 chsp

Round 7: Cl A, (5 dc in chsp , skip trpop, sc inch, skip trpop) repeat around, sl st in dc. **18 groups of 5** dc, **18 sc**

Round 8: Cl B, (4 dc in the back loop of sc, skip 2 dc, sc in the back loop, skip 2 dc) repeat around, sl st in dc. 18 groups of 4 dc, 18 sc

Round 9: Cl A (1 dc in each of 4 dc, skip sc) repeat around, sl st in dc. 72 dc

Round 10: Cl A, 1 dc in each st around, sl st in dc. 72 dc

Round 11 - 12: Cl A, 1 sc in each st around, sl st in sc. 72 dc. Fasten off, but save a long end.
