



Potholder Twister Design Frostvirka - Ellinor Widéen

Yarn: Viking Vår, Scheepjes Cahlista or similar aran weight yarn from Favoritgarner.se
Approximately 52 gram of yarn for one potholder

Hook: 4,0 mm

Size: 19 x 19 cm

US terms used:

st - stitch

sc – single crochet

sl st – slip stitch

hdc – half double crochet

chsp – chain space

dc – double crochet

sc2tog – Insert hook into chsp and draw up a loop. Insert hook into next chsp and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook

Fphdc – front post half double crochet

Make a chain-ring, chain 4, sl st in initial ch 1.

"Twister" one

Round 1: (ch 2, 1 dc in chain-ring, ch 1, 1 dc in chain-ring, ch 2, sl st in ch-ring) x 4. Fasten off.



The following twisters

Make a chain-ring, chain 4, sl st in initial ch 1.

Round 1: Ch 2, 1 dc in the ring, ch 1, 1 dc in the ring, ch 2, sl st in the ring, ch 2, 1 dc in the ring, take out the hook from the loop, put the hook, from above, in chsp on your previous twister, pick up the loop and pull yarn through chsp, continue on your second twister, 1 dc in chsp, ch 2, sl st in chsp,



ch 2, 1 dc in chsp, take out the hook from the loop, put the hook, from above, in next chsp on your previous twister, pick up the loop and pull yarn through chsp, continue on your second twister, 1 dc in chsp, ch 2, sl st in chsp,
ch 2, 1 dc in chsp, ch 1, 1 dc in chsp, ch 2, sl st in chsp. Fasten off.



Continue to make more twisters and join them in to a row in the same way. Every twister is joined to the previous twister in two places. My potholder is made of 7 x 7 twisters.

Row 2

Twister 1 on row 2, is joined to the first twister on row 1, the same way as previous twisters, with two joining places.



Twister 2 is joined to the others the same way as previous ones, but every new twister is now joined to the previous one **and** to the one below on row 1, three joining places.

When all your twisters are joined, it is time for the border.

Border

Round 1:

Start in any chsp in a corner, **1 sc + ch 16 + 1 sc** in chsp, *(ch 3, skip **1 dc + ch 2 + ch 2 + 1 dc**, sc2tog in the following two chsp) x 6, ch 3, skip **1 dc + ch 2 + ch 2 + 1 dc**, **sc + ch 2 + sc** in chsp, repeat from* around, but the last time, make sl st in initial sc after ch 3.



1 sc + ch 16 + 1 sc in chsp



ch 3, skip **1 dc + ch 2 + ch 2 + 1 dc**, sc2tog in the following two chsp

Round 2: Ch 1, 18 sc in chsp, sl st in sc, *(4 hdc in chsp, 1 fphdc in sc2tog) x 6, 4 hdc in chsp, 1 fphdc in sc, **1 hdc + ch 2 + 1 hdc** in chsp, 1 fphdc in sc, repeat from* around, but the last time, make sl st in initial ch after 4 hdc in chsp.



ch 1, 18 sc in chsp, sl st in sc, 4 hdc in chsp, 1 fphdc in sc2tog



Extra round-

1 sl st in the back loop of every st around, except for the chsp in the corners where you make 3 sc in chsp.
